I watched a farmer dance in a field today.  
He was surrounded by people clapping  
and singing, and then others joined in  
with the dancing, scuffing the dry earth in

**celebration, but taking care to avoid the vegetable crop yet to be harvested.**

The setting was a Mozambican village and [the dance](#) was for you, as a thank you for their bumper crop, made possible by your support for BMS World Mission. Because of the agricultural programme you help fund, farmers in the village can provide more food and money for their families.

The results, as BMS worker Carlos Jone will tell you in this week's [story](#), are visible, with villagers no longer going hungry. And this isn't the only transformation you've been part of through your support for agricultural training. People in the mountains of Afghanistan are learning how to grow vegetables, and in Uganda, 100 households are now farming chillies and bananas, with the income helping to pay for school fees and medical bills.

None of this work would have happened without your generosity and God's faithfulness. Now there's a good reason to dance!

- Pray for development in fragile states such as Afghanistan, where BMS workers are overseeing work aimed at ending vulnerability and building shalom.


- Pray for Chico and others benefitting from a BMS livelihoods project in Mozambique. Pray that they would bless their community.
