When Jamie met Justin

Last month the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, visited Park to meet with one of our CAP clients, Jamie. Here's what happened...

To say it was a surreal moment was putting it mildly; walking under the arch and marching towards the church was an entourage of clerical collars and official-looking people. Front and centre was none other than the Archbishop of Canterbury!

Unfortunately they'd come in the wrong way because playgroup have the gates locked,

and as safeguarding trumps all clergy however famous they were promptly told to spin around and come in through the side gate!

Fortunately the only way was up, and within a couple of minutes Justin Welby was sitting down with Peter, Pat Hillier and, most importantly, Jamie, one of our CAP clients.

As a patron of CAP,

Archbishop Justin was keen to find out how the work is supporting people in our town, and what role the church has played in it.

Jamie was understandably nervous at first, but the Archbishop's warm tone of voice and genuine concern for hearing about his circumstances soon put him at ease, and he began to open up. Losing his job coupled with mental health problems had led to spiralling debt, but he had discovered a hope that exceeded far beyond balancing his bank account. CAP had offered him a lifeline, and Pat explained how the work was desperately needed in Great Yarmouth and

Remarkably, the Archbishop then began to open up about his own experiences of mental health problems with his daughters and his willingness to be vulnerable was both humbling and inspiring.

Sadly our time was cut short due to his previous engagements overrunning, but we closed with a time of prayer for Jamie which he

Since then, Jamie has been at church and has found a job. He continues to pay into his CAP plan and is an inspiring example of how God is working through this ministry to transform lives in Great Yarmouth. Let's pray that even more lives are touched in 2019.
