PRAYER REQUEST



CHURCH AWAY DAY - 6TH JULY

We are excited to be spending the day together at Lighthouse Baptist Church, Sheringham, on Saturday 6th July. There is a sign-up sheet on the information table at church. Please sign up asap if you are intending on coming as we need to let Sheringham know numbers by the end of May.

PROJECT 18

May is a big month for us here at Park as we prayerfully consider a possible new site to relocate to. The site we are considering is a piece of land on North Quay, next to the red bridge that links the train station to the Conge (*see pictures below*). The Leadership Team are calling on all church members to commit to a time of prayer and fasting in order to seek clarity on God's leading.

We are meeting for prayer at various times throughout May:

Friday 10th, 7pm: Joint Prayer Meeting

Thursday 16th, 23rd, 30th, 7.30pm: Prayer Meeting

Saturday 18th, 5pm: Site Visit & Prayer Walk


Friday 31st May, 7.30pm Church Meeting to reflect and discuss what God has been saying. A decision to be made whether to continue investigating this site.

Sat 1st June, 6.30pm: Joint Service followed by lots of food to celebrate the end of our fasting.

If you have never fasted before, then a simple guide is to choose what you will fast from and the time period for your fast. This could be to skip a meal, such as lunch, once or twice a week, or to cut a food out of your diet entirely for the whole month. You may wish to increase your fasting as the month develops, until you are fasting for an entire day. It is important to continue to drink water through your fast, and consider including herbal tea or fruit juice if fasting for longer periods. If a health condition would put you at risk, then consider fasting from something else, such as social media or television.

The purpose of our fasting is to make more time for God. Invite God to speak to you about the land, take the time to read the Bible, and write down anything you think God might be saying to you. The purpose of us doing this together as a church is that we humbly share what we think God might be saying, based not on the first things that come into our head, but after serious time spent in prayer and reflection. Encourage your house group and prayer triplet to meet to pray and discuss this, too.

We have already recognised the need for a new home, in order for us to better serve and worship God, to continue the integration of the congregations and to enable our outreach to the community to flourish. The key task is to ensure that God is leading and directing and to seek the place that God has for us.
